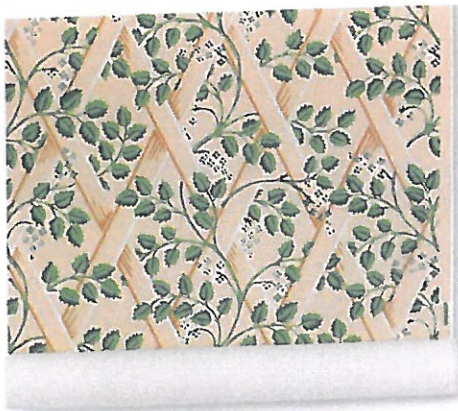
Edith Wharton's Botanical Tiles

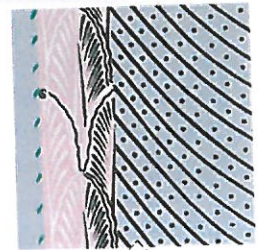
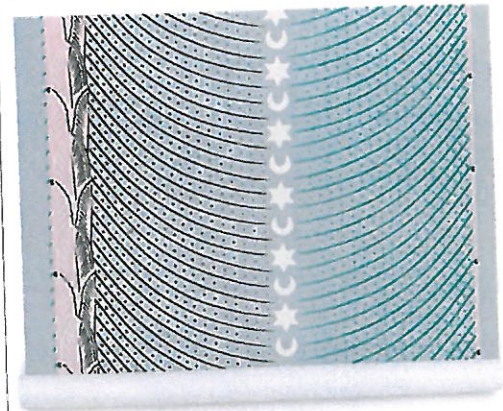
Jefferson Trellis
